APPLICANTS MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS

- Hold an appropriate teaching qualification (a diploma recognised and validated by the relevant national authorities) to teach Catalan.
- Have proven experience teaching Catalan as a first and/or mother tongue language.
- Have experience working in an international educational environment.
- Have recent teaching experience in the Nursery, Primary and/or Secondary years. Have experience in designing, administering and evaluating both formative and summative assessments.
- Demonstrate an interest in and commitment to differentiated teaching and learning.
- Demonstrate a high level of professionalism and a strong commitment to pupils' well-being.
- Be a European citizen or hold a valid work permit for employment in Italy.

PREFERENCE WILL BE GIVEN TO A TEACHER WHO:

- Has experience teaching in a European or international school
- Integrates new technologies as pedagogical tools
- Speaks vehicular languages (EN - FR - DE) or Italian, as language of the host country. This will be considered an asset.
- Is flexible in the schedule.



WE OFFER

We are offering contracts in accordance with the Service regulations for the locally recruited teachers in the European schools (Ref.: 2016-05-D-11-en-7) available on the official site website of the European Schools: www.eursc.eu

Starting day : 1st September 2026.

Schedule: Catalan classes are scheduled between Monday and Friday and consist of two 45-minute periods per week (90 minutes total) for a group of four children attending different levels: two in P3 and two in P5. The exact teaching allocation in the Secondary Cycle will depend on student enrolment and is expected to range from 3 to 6 periods per week (135–270 minutes).

Salary: Monthly gross salary: **€1078,83** corresponding to an estimated net salary of approximately **€915** (based solely on the remuneration for three teaching periods in the Secondary Cycle). The salary is paid in **13 monthly installments per year**.

Should all six periods in the Secondary Cycle be reached, the gross salary will be **€1901,70** and the net salary will be **€1520**.

Type of contract : one year contract (renewable) in accordance with the Service regulation for the locally recruited teachers in the European schools.

Location : Varese, Italy

Additional info related to the contract: the contract includes additional benefits—such as school fees, removal costs, installation allowance, and others—which may vary according to the candidate's family composition and the number of hours stipulated in the contract.
